Easily the star of the show, the 2012 Suendero (79% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Petit Verdot and 4% Malbec) offers classic Cabernet notes of cassis, toasted bread, jammy blackberries and toasted spice in its full-bodied, beautifully textured personality. It has ripe tannin, solid mid-palate depth and tons of charm. Drink bottles anytime over the coming decade.
