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Wine of the Week

"This Galician grape's heritage is not well known, and may be related to Viognier—at least its aroma of peaches and apricots with a Gewurztraminer-like spice note remind me of Viognier. Since Paso Robles is a warm area, this wine is quite a surprise. It has the weight of a light red (with 14.5% alcohol), but the freshness of a light white. Serve well-chilled with ceviche or shrimp salad with lime." —Dan Berger
