It is then transferred from the earth through the vine as the grapes are harvested, crushed, fermented into wine and eventually bottled. The role of the winemaker is to respectfully steward this life with care and attention to detail."

Looking ahead, Willenborg's winemaking style is in line with the Vina Robles vision. "Kevin will be able to build on a solid foundation we have established over the past twelve years. We appreciate his team approach to winegrowing and his passion in working with the vines and allowing the grapes to express their terroir and elegance," says managing partner, Hans-R. Michel.
