The grapes for our Zinfandel were grown on our Hospitality Center, Pleasant Valley and Jardine estate vineyards then handpicked and sorted in the cool morning hours. They were gently crushed and then allowed to ferment in small stainless steel tanks. Various pump-over techniques were utilized during the progressive stages of fermentation to enhance fruit extraction and enrich mouthfeel.

The wine was then transferred into barrels to complete malolactic fermentation and spent 20 months aging in French and American oak barrels. A small amount of Petite Sirah was blended in for complexity and added mouthfeel.

Tasting Notes

COLOR: Garnet

AROMA: Dark plum and raspberry along with amaretto, coffee and caramel; hints of white pepper and coriander

TASTE: Medium-bodied with blue and red fruits, moderate acidity, smooth texture rolls onto the finish
